



## **DID YOU KNOW THAT NEMCSA HEAD START...**

- Receives nearly \$14 million from the Federal Department of Health and Human Services to provide quality, comprehensive pre-school services to 2457 children.
- Receives \$818,400 from the Michigan Department of Education to provide pre-school services to 248 children.
- Provides a quality, developmentally appropriate curriculum designed to prepare children for kindergarten. These services are provided by either part-day, full day, full year or home based service delivery models.
- Provides programs at 90 locations in 21 counties and is geographically the largest Head Start program in the United States.
- Enrollment consists of an average of 17% children with disabilities.
- In addition to pre-school, is a family focused program who's mission is to "STRENGTHEN FAMILIES THROUGH QUALITY EARLY CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES".
- Works in partnership with other agencies providing services to low income families to maximize all available resources.
