

School Success Program

2002 - 2003

- ☞ Any child who is experiencing difficulties, regardless of family income, may be referred to the School Success Program.
- ☞ In 2002 - 2003, the School Success Program worked with 221 formal (in-depth) cases. These services included bi-weekly home visits, weekly contact with the child, and the implementation of an action plan.
- ☞ The program also provided an intervention service (informal) to 1,100 additional children.
- ☞ In 2002 - 2003, the School Success staff trained over 1,800 elementary children to use the Peer Mediation Program.
- ☞ The School Success staff facilitates small groups that focus on divorce, anger management, children of addictions, friendship, bullying, and many more.
- ☞ In 2002 - 2003, the School Success staff had 8,936 face-to-face contacts with children on their formal caseloads and performed over 1,000 home visits.
- ☞ The School Success staff is also responsible for all truancy that arise in the elementary buildings.
