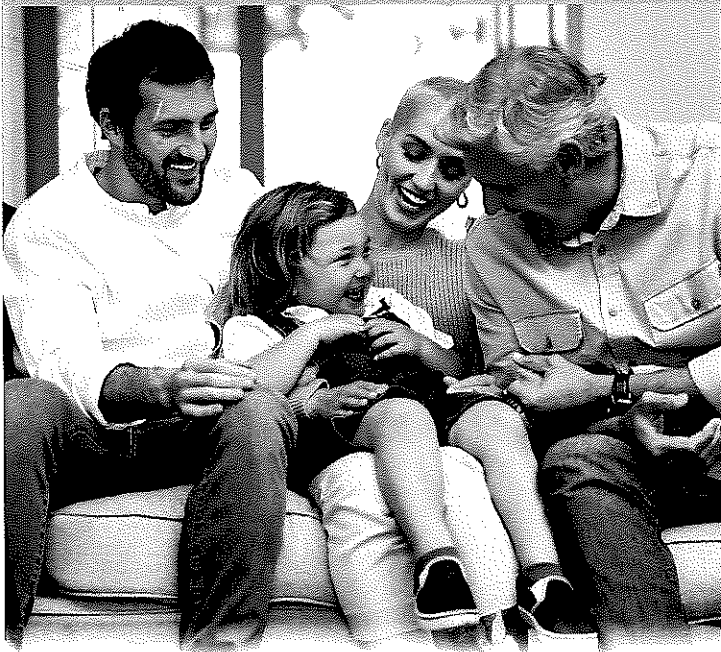


Survivors, Families, Friends & Caregivers
