- Annual contracts beginning October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024
- Submission of Proposals-Due date
- Target Population age 60 and above except Kinship 55+ (Found on the Kinship Guidelines)
- Proposal Review Process (Scoring sheet used by Committee is included with Application Info)
- Appeals Procedure included in Application Info

Application Info (continued)

- Cash Match 10%
- Program Income Reminder: Employee(s) handling program income must be bonded.
- Budget Form
 - Amount Requested = How much grant funding is being requested
 - Support from Other Resources Program Income and cash match 10%
 - Sum of those two columns is the project total
- Budget Narrative
 - Clear explanation on how units were calculated
 - Minimum Standard Assurance (may be completed once for all programs requesting, if all programs are listed)

- All programs must meet level III criteria
 - * Refer to TL 2012-244
- On application, if other is chosen, # 12 in Project Narrative must be completed

Region 9 AAA FY 2024 Goals

- Goal 1: Improve access of aging service to Black, Indigenous, People of Color and LGBTQ+ older adults in northeast Michigan.
- Goal 2: Reduce the impact of social isolation on older adults and improve access to information, assistance, and social outlets through a variety of means to improve the lives of aging adults in northeast Michigan.
- Goal 3: Ensure older adults have a robust, well-trained workforce to serve their needs.
- Goal 4: Ensure access to services and supports in a manner consistent with person-centered practices.

Application – Title IIIE National Family Caregiver Support

- Tentative FY 24 Funding by category
 - EST (Caregiver Education, Support, Training)
 \$25,000
 - Kinship \$19,562
 - Respite Care \$50,000
 - Evidence Based Disease Prevention \$ 15,000
- Complete one Budget for each different category.
- ACLS Operating Standard: C-20 EST, C-18 Kinship, B-10 Respite, C-18 EBDP

Application – Merit Award Tentative FY 24 Funding \$117,323

- Combined Funding of Merit I, Merit II, and State Caregiver Support (submit only one application)
- Available funding covers the following services:
 - Establishing and ADC where none currently exist
 - Expanding or enhancing existing ADC
 - On-going support of ADC
- Cost Sharing Schedule must be submitted with application.
- ACLS Operating Standard C-1

Application – Title VII Elder Abuse Prevention Tentative FY 24 Funding - \$6,394

- Activities to develop, strengthen and carry-out programs for prevention and treatment of elder abuse, neglect and exploitation.
 - Professional/paraprofessional training
 - Community outreach (Elder Abuse Conference)
 - Public education
 - Case consultation
- Units of Service-one hour of contact with organizations to develop coordinated, comprehensive services for target population
- ACLS Operating Standard C-15

Things to Review

- Budget totals and budget narrative totals should equal
- Read the Standards to ensure the program is following guidelines
- Ensure all attachments are included (where applicable)
- Complete all sections (do not skip unless instructed to do so)
- Ensure Project Narrative Questions are answered
